






#### **Build and Establish Traditions and Celebrations**

- Celebrations can be simple or grand, small or large

### MOY Strategies to Keep MTSS Momentum Strong


- MOY Universal Screening and data review
- Continued implementation of interventions while simultaneously analyzing our MTSS Workflow
- Action planning for systems and structures that needed to be revised
- Gradually adding components to our MTSS
   Framework to ensure sustainable growth



#### How to determine if your MTSS implementation is on track?

Plan, Do, Study, Act (PDSA) is a continuous improvement method we can use to guide this improvement of MTSS implementation:

- Plan: Identify a specific goal and establish a clear plan for achieving it.
- **Do**: Execute the plan
- Study: Analyze the results, comparing outcomes to expectations
- Act: Based on the findings, adjust the plan and add components as needed


#### Re: The Health of Your School's Core

District/School provides clear expectations regarding teaching and learning.

- The district provides required classroom tools/resources (content and assessment) needed for student success
- Instruction is standards based and student work reflects that alignment
- Instructors are highly skilled, have content knowledge, deliver engaging lessons and students are informed of the standards they must meet Instructional strategies are research based and are routinely differentiated, responding to students' exceptionalities, language and cultural needs
- Instructional materials are provided in multiple formats over the course of a lesson or unit
- Instructional staff collaboratively plan and document teaching and learning intent Core Workout Worksheet
- Instructors use a variety of strategies to assess learning
- Instructional staff routinely analyze and use diagnostic tools to determine the impact of teaching on learning and make adjustments
- Instructional Staff routinely receives specific feedback from content experts and school level administrators

## The Universal Screener Debate: When is the best time to give the MOY Universal Screener?

- Option 1: Administer the MOY Universal Screener toward the end of January
  - Gives time for students to settle back into school <u>after</u> Winter Break
  - Action Plan to make adjustments will start around the beginning of February
  - o Might be a hard time of year to find time for professional learning
- Option 2: Administer the MOY Universal Screener around the first or second week of December
  - Students are screened <u>before</u> Winter Break.
  - o Data can be used to create an Action Plan to make adjustments starting in January
  - Most districts have professional learning time before students return in January
  - The new year becomes a fresh restart to your MTSS implementation


#### MTSS Coaching Menu

Choose from various options for ways to offer modeling, coaching, or support to your team.

<b>Appetizers</b> Preparing for a lesson	<b>Main Entrees</b> During a lesson	<b>Dessert</b> Follow up after a lesson
Gathering resources/ research Provide resources around a certain strategy or topic	Classroom Assistant Actively help during a lesson	Feedback & Reflection  Ask guiding questions to help teacher reflect and identify priorities for growth
Assistance in Planning Meet to collaboratively plan, analyze data, or brainstorm around a lesson	<b>Demonstration of a lesson</b> Model a lesson while the teacher observes	Collaboration  Facilitate a collaborative discussion with colleagues
<b>Differentiation</b> Help create differentiated resources for a lesson	<b>Team Teaching</b> Lead a lesson together with the teacher	Goal Setting Help set professional goals
Substitute  Cover a class so the teacher can observe in another classroom	<b>Observation</b> Watch the lesson and gather data for discussion	Listening & Support  Lend a listening ear to process or talk through a challenge
